



APONLINE to Sanchaypost Migration Procedures

Prerequisite:

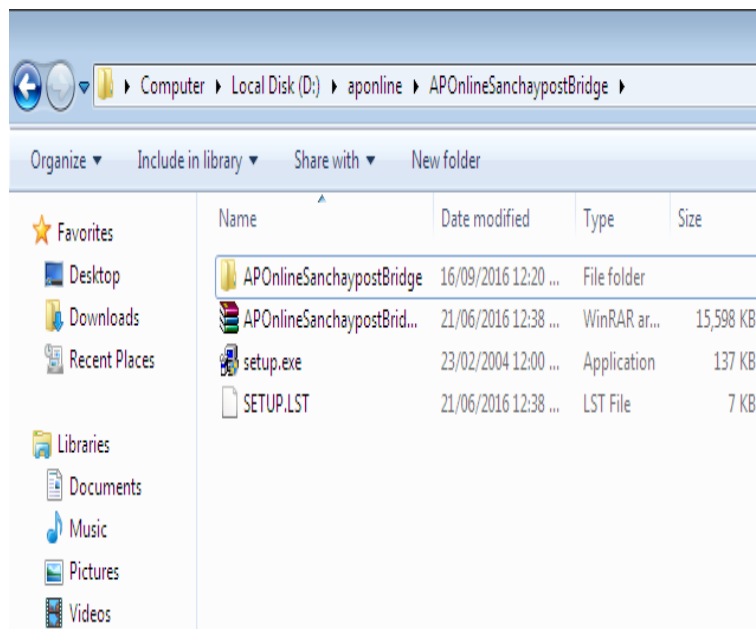
1. The system should be installed with SQL 2008 any edition with minimum 2 GB RAM
2. Ensure that Backup of all databases relating to Sanchay Post are taken and stored in External storage devices.
3. Restore the database "APONLINE" (in the same name) shared by the APOnline for that Post office.

Note:

For successful execution of this tool, existence of these three databases (POST ,BPRO & APONLINE) is mandatory.

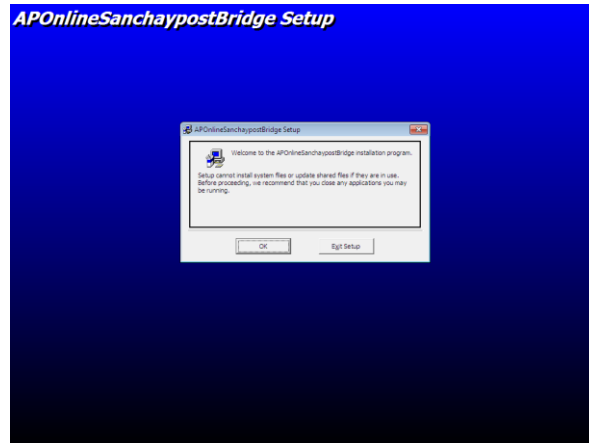
Steps for installation

- a) Run 'Set up.exe' available in the folder APOnlineSanchaypostBridge

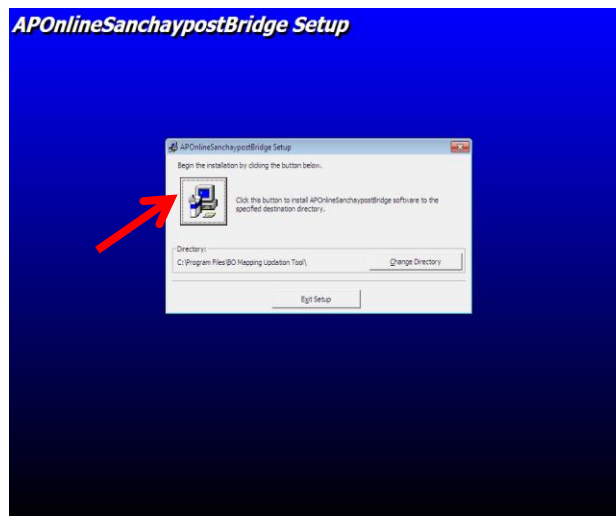

b) Click “OK” in “APOnlineSanchaypostBridge Setup” as given below:

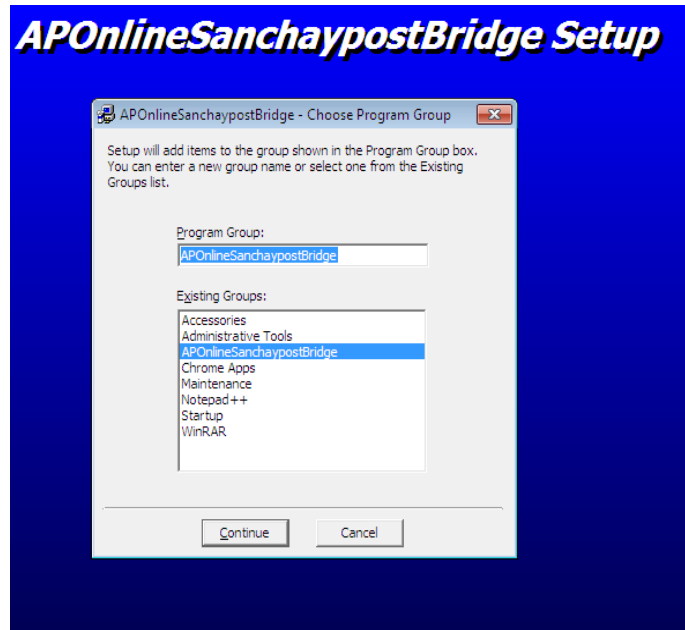


c) In the next window, click install image to install the application (as shown in picture)

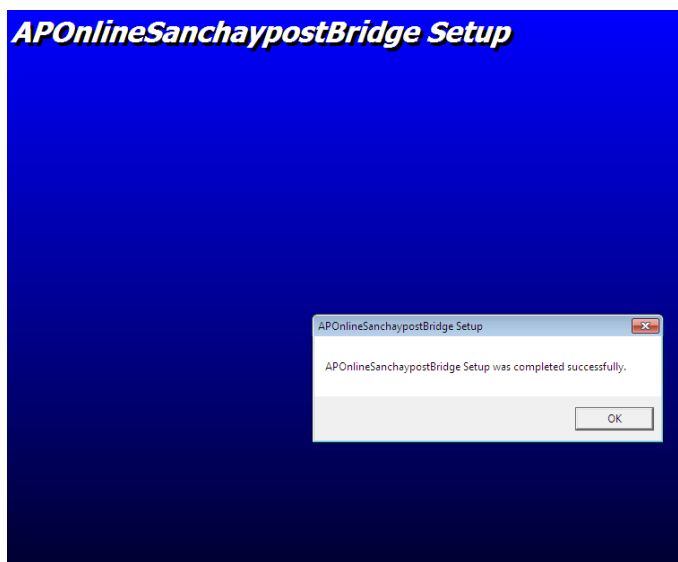

- d) Click continue to proceed the installation



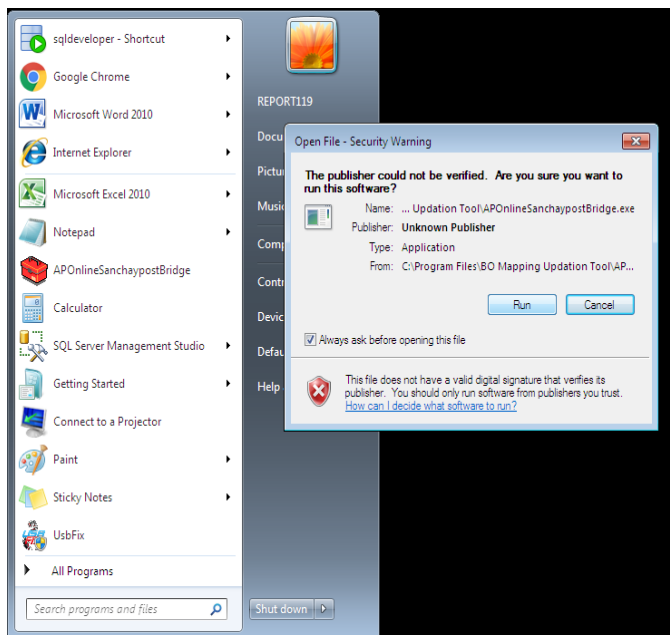
- e) Click on “ok” button.
f) Your “APonline sanchay post bridge” installation is complete now.



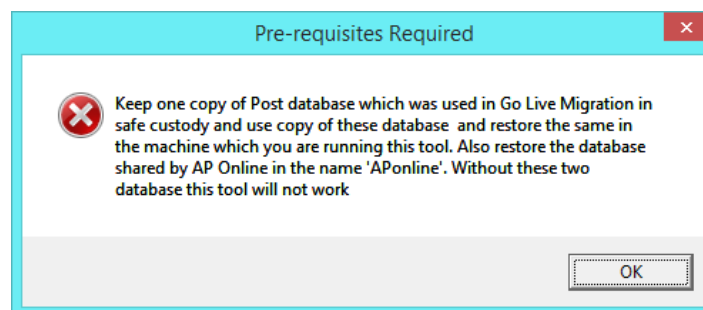

Steps for Execution Procedure of the Tool

- g) After installation, double click on the Aponlinesanchaypostbridge icon to make it run as Administrator



- h) It will ask to restart the Application. Kindly rerun the tool by following the step (e) as said previously will end up in prompting the Prerequisite error, click “ok” if the backup has already been taken to proceed further.



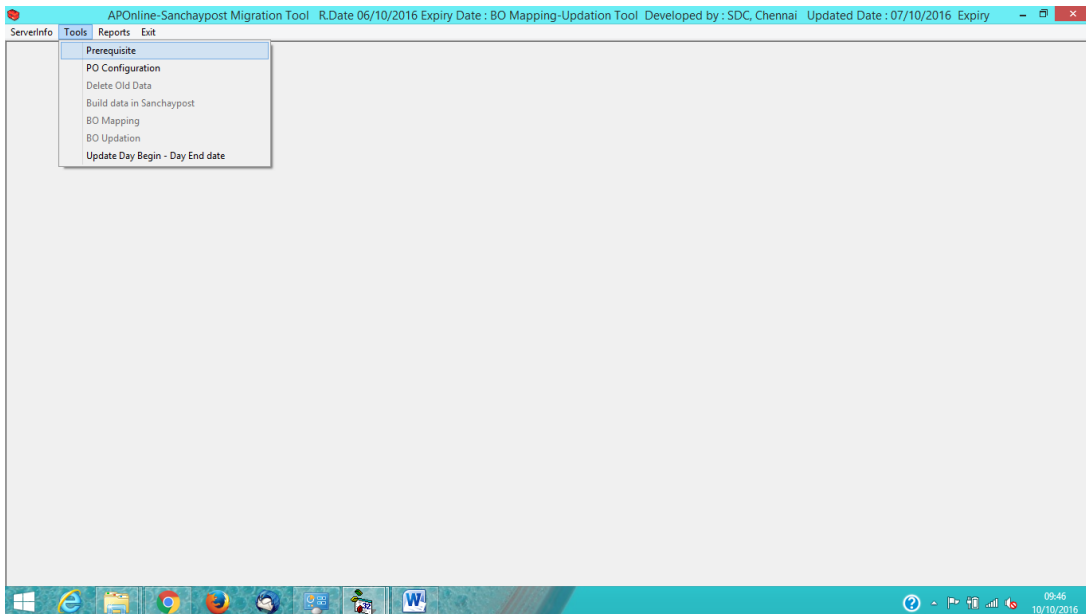

- i) Please Type the Server Name and SA Password and click “SAVE” and click “CONNECT” which will save the Login credential for future logins. Select Account type as AP even for Telangana also.

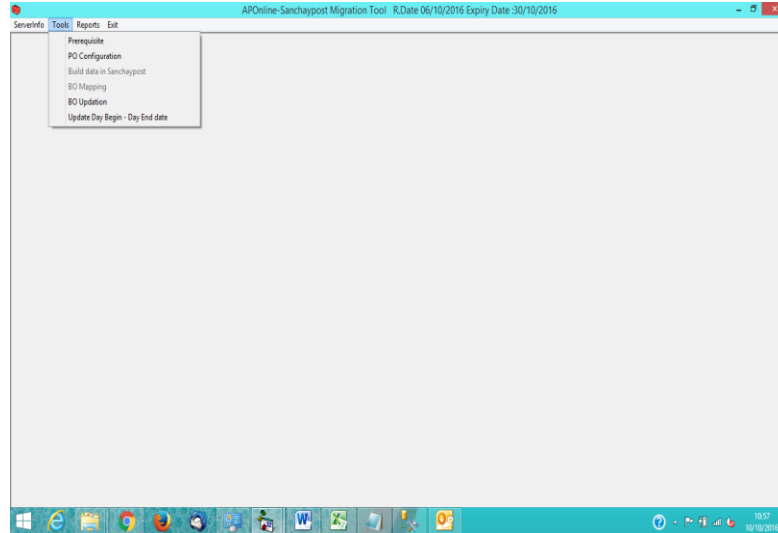
- j) Open SQL Query Analyser and then run the Script “aponline.sql” which available in the setup folder
- k) On saving the server information next step click Tool tab listed in the APonline Sanchaypost Mapping tool menu.

- l) Click on “Prerequisite” , after completion proceed to next step as mention in the tool menu “Configuration of Post offices”



- m) Click on “Configuration of Post offices” . Enter the Pincode of the office and click Fetch. In the Dropdown box will show all the PO Name having that Pincode. Select the appropriate PO Name and press “ENTER” key this will show status of the PO, HO Name and SOLID. Enter the Sanchaypost Code and then click on “Update” This will update the PO Name and BO details for which you want to generate Sanchaypost data.

n) After completion proceed to next step as mention in the tool menu “Build data in Sanchaypost”

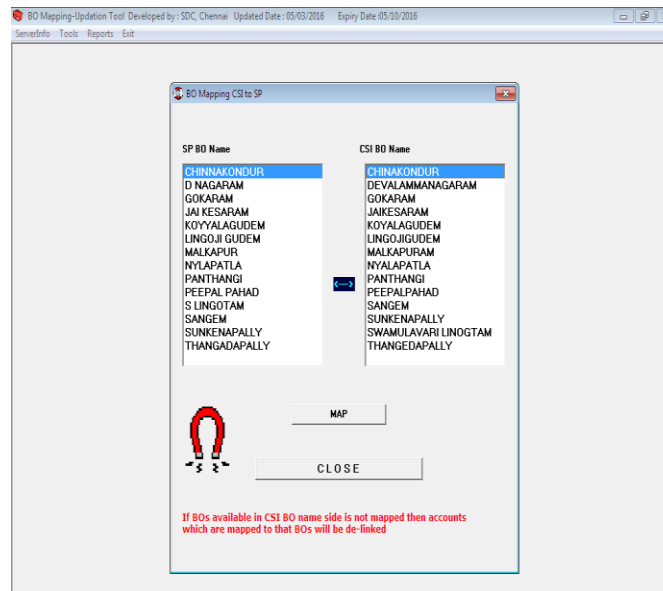

o) After successful building data in Sanchaypost proceed to next setup “BO MAP”



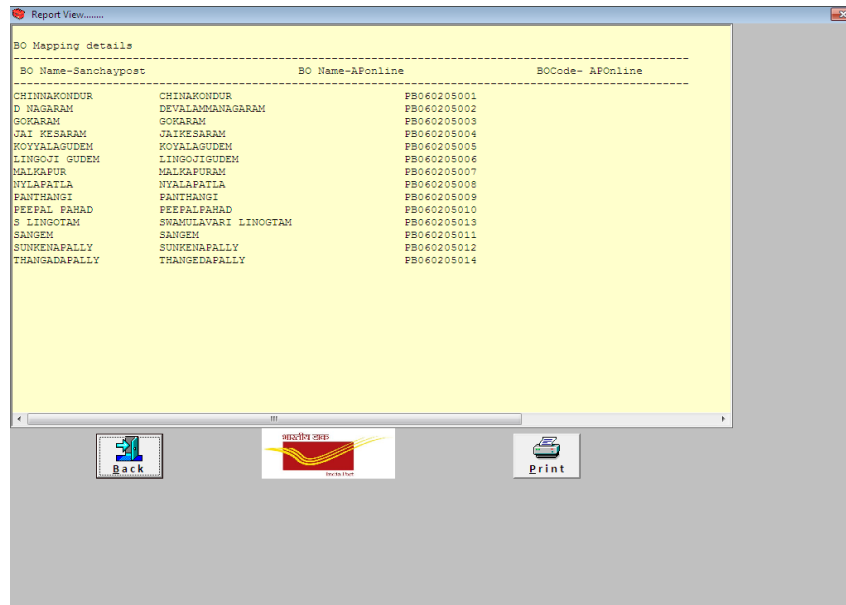
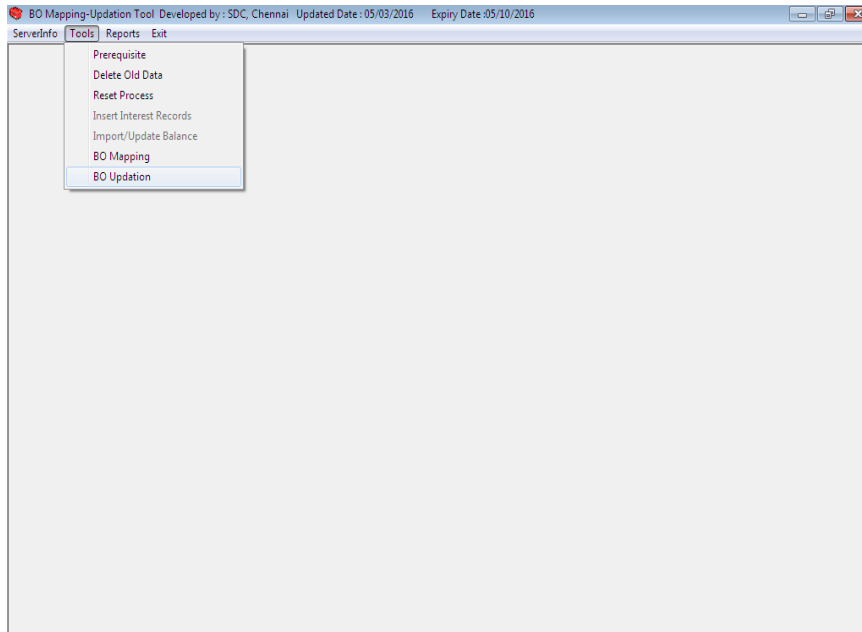
Map the BO NAME as listed in Sanchay Post BO name and CSI NO Name, if BOs available in CSI BOname side not mapped then the accounts which are mapped to that BOs will be de-linked. After successful mapping of BOs click “close” button





APONLINE to Sanchaypost Migration Procedures

- p) After completion proceed to “BO updation” option. First it will shown if any BO mapping done for APonline and Sanchaypost . Click on “Back” button. It will ask for confirmation to proceed further. If Yes it will replace all the APonline BO code with Sanchaypost BO name.

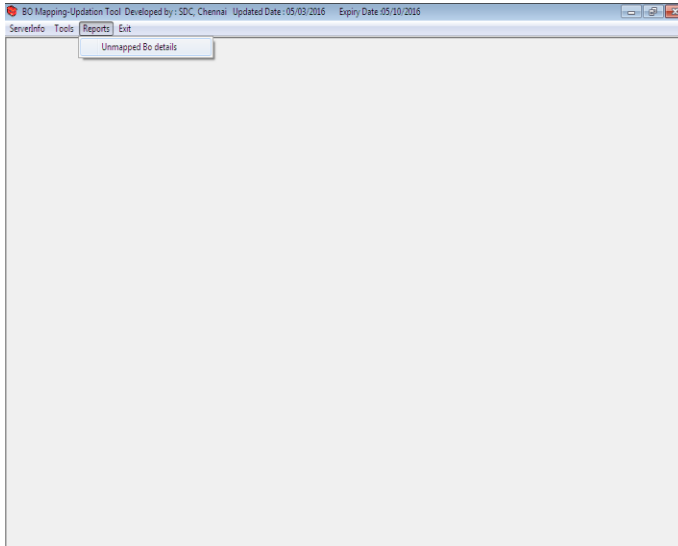


Print the Mapped BOs list for confirmation of BO mapping and keep it under safe custody.

- q) Reports of Unmapped BOs list can be viewed under Report Menu select “unmapped BO details



- r) To ensure APOnline data is transferred to Sanchaypost following tables with parameters may be checked.
1. Indexreg – Actype will be (AP / TS) , Addr1 will have APOnline BO code and no column should be null
 2. Ledger - No column should be null
 3. BO_details – It should have all the BO accounts mapped to Sanchaypost BO Names
 4. Default_PO_name – It should contains correct Office name
 5. Nominee_info – No column should be null.
 6. Nregs_jobcard_acctno - No column should be null and it should contain data
- s) During Migration Day End and Day Begin date should be updated using “Update Day Begin-Day End date”

After completion of above said process using the Migration tool given by CEPT, Chennai share the required file for migration.

TO BE NOTED :

- 1) For First time running of Tool it will ask Server Name and Password after providing Credentials
It will Ask Type in that Please Select as **“ANDHRA PRADESH (AP)”** Only
Don't Select Telangana (TS)
- 2) Please Take Back up of Post Database after Clicking Last Option in Tool “Update Day
Begin/END” and Preserve backup Securely (Because for every Time running the Tool will Erase
the whole Data of Post Database)
- 3) No need to Restore Post Database every Time.
- 4) Sign Database also should be presented.
