Jasmine (*Jasminum sambac* Aiton) is one of the most important fragrant flower crops grown commercially for loose flowers. Jasmine buds are used for making garlands, bouquets, for religious offerings and for the production of perfumed oils and attars. Jasmine is an evergreen semi vining shrub. It contains around 200 species native to tropical and warm temperate regions of Eurasia, Australasia and Oceania. It has oval green rich leaves, which have five to nine leaflets. Each leaflet is 2-3 inches long. Jasmines are widely cultivated for the characteristic fragrance of their flowers. Jasmine flowers are white in colour. Its stems are slender, trailing, green and glamorous.

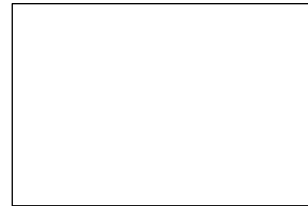
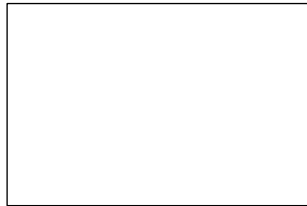

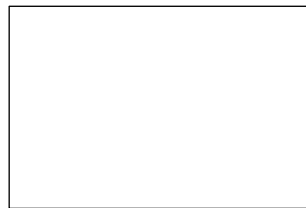
